

Port Colborne accepting grant applications for non-profit organizations

Port Colborne, ON (Jan. 7, 2022) – The city is accepting the first round of grant applications from non-profit organizations until Monday, Jan. 31, 2022.

The granting committee, established in Dec. 2015 when council passed by-law 6317/143/15, distributes approximately \$30,000 annually to non-profit organizations, charitable organizations, and service organizations that benefit the citizens of Port Colborne and enhance the quality of life of the community.

The second due date for applications in 2022 is June 30, 2022; however, organizations can only apply once in a fiscal period.
