

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE

BY-LAW NO. 5715/146/11

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 5503/100/10 BEING A BY-LAW TO
MANAGE AND REGULATE MUNICIPAL PARKS**

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Port Colborne enacted By-law 5503/100/10, Being a By-Law to Manage and Regulate Municipal Parks on the 26th day of July 2010;

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous of amending By-law 5503/100/10 in accordance with the Memorandum received from S. Hanson, Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, dated October 20, 2011 Re House-keeping Amendment to Municipal Parks By-law.

**NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Bylaw 5503/100/10 Being a Bylaw to Manage and Regulate Municipal Parks, be amended by deleting from Section 55 thereof the following:

“An Enforcement Officer upon discovery of any Vehicle parked, stopped or standing in contravention of section 34 of this by-law may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the Vehicles which may be enforced in the manner provided by the Repair and Storage Liens Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter R.25, as amended.” **and replacing it with the following:** “An Enforcement Officer upon discovery of any Vehicle parked, stopped or standing in contravention of section 29 of this by-law may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the Vehicles which may be enforced in the manner provided by the Repair and Storage Liens Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter R.25, as amended.”

2. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
