Remember that deep, dark colours produce a better illustration. The contest is open to all children who live or go to school in Port Colborne; up to and including those in Grade 8.

Time is of the essence: to be chosen and reproduced for printing in time for the holiday season, all submissions must be received at the Mayor’s Office in City Hall, 66 Charlotte St., Port Colborne ON L3K 3G8 by **Friday, Oct. 15, 2021 at 4 p.m. If dropping off in person, please knock on the front door or place in the mail slot on the front east side of the building.**
